House Bill 1113 (Delegate Kagan. *et al.*)

Ways and Means

Public School Holidays - Presidents' Day and Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

This bill establishes Presidents' Day and Martin Luther King, Jr. Day as public school holidays. The bill also repeals the requirement that public schools devote a part of the day to appropriate exercises on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Adding additional holidays to the public school calendar will not alter the number of days that schools are required to remain in session. Currently, all 24 school systems are closed on Presidents' Day and Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

Small Business Effect: None.
