Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore County - Hannah More School

This bill provides \$800,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Hannah More School for the planning, design, repair, renovation, construction, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a gymnasium on the premises of the Hannah More School.

The Hannah More School must provide \$800,000 in matching funds by June 1, 2001. The Hannah More School shall grant and convey a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$800,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
