## **Election Code - Ballots - Identification of Candidates**

This bill requires the State Board of Elections to assign a numeric or alpha-numeric identifier for each candidate for a primary or general election. The identifier must be listed on a ballot next to the candidate's name. Under current law, only a candidate's name is required to be on a ballot.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill's provisions would not materially affect the State Board of Elections' finances.

**Local Effect:** None. Local boards of election could include a numeric or alpha-numeric identifier on a ballot with existing resources.
