House Bill 314 (Delegates K. Kelly and Vallario)

Judiciary

Commercial Law - Attachment of Wages - Statement of Payments

This bill repeals the requirement that a judgment creditor file monthly with the clerk of the court a written statement showing all payments that were credited to the judgment debtor's account during the pendency of an attachment of wages.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Eliminating the monthly reporting requirement on wage liens to the clerk of the court would not materially affect State operations or finances.
