### Courts and Judicial Proceedings - Insurance Agreements - Disclosure

This bill provides that an insured or third party who has filed a written claim with a property and casualty insurer may obtain from the insurer documentation of any insurance agreement under which any insurer may be liable to satisfy part or all of the claim or indemnify or reimburse for payments made to satisfy the claim. The insurer must provide the documentation within 60 days of the written request.
