House Bill 984 (Delegate Patterson. *et al.*)

Ways and Means

Education - Noncertificated Employees - Prohibitions on Hiring

This bill prohibits a local board of education from knowingly hiring an individual as a noncertificated employee if the individual has been convicted of specified crimes. This bill only applies to individuals applying for employment after July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prohibiting local school systems from hiring certain individuals would not affect local expenditures. School officials should be able to fill employment vacancies absent these individuals.

Small Business Effect: None.
