FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1074 (Delegate Guns) Environmental Matters

Natural Resources - Fish - Prohibition

This bill prohibits a person from catching fish placed under a moratorium by the State. The bill provides that a person observed violating the provisions of the bill by catching five or more of a single species of fish that is under a moratorium is subject to specified penalties.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Potential minimal increase in general fund revenues and expenditures due to the bill's penalty provision. Potential minimal special fund revenue increase.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Fiscal Analysis

State Effect: The applicable criminal penalty provisions are not expected to significantly affect State finances or operations.

Local Effect: The applicable penalty provisions are not expected to significantly affect local finances or operations.
