Senate Bill 414 (Senator Ruben, et al.)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Montgomery County - Darnestown Youth Facility

This bill provides \$750,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Victory Youth Centers, Inc. for the planning, design, development, construction, and capital equipping of a youth facility to be located in Darnestown to provide recreational, social, and athletic programs for youth.

The board of directors must provide \$750,000 in matching funds by June 1, 2001. The matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this bill. No portion of the proceeds of the loan or the matching fund may be used for sectarian religious purposes.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$750,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
