Senate Bill 454 (Senator Della)

Judicial Proceedings

Vehicle Laws - Rental Vehicles - Registration Cards

This bill allows a valid rental agreement to be used in place of a registration card in the case of a rental vehicle that is (1) rented under Maryland law; or (2) rented or leased for up to 180 days and registered in another state. Current law requires an individual who is driving or in control of a vehicle to carry a registration card in the vehicle.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Potential negligible decrease in general fund revenues as fewer citations would be issued for failure to display a registration card. Such violations carry a fine of \$30. Expenditures would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.
