House Bill 175 (Delegate Kittleman)

Commerce and Government Matters

Election Law - Campaign Finance - Elimination of Slates

This bill repeals the authority for 2 or more candidates to form a political committee known as a "slate" and related provisions. Under current law a slate may be formed by 2 or more candidates to conduct and pay for joint campaign activities. There is no limit on the amount of money that can be transferred among candidate members of a slate.
