## Motor Vehicle Administration - New Drivers - Identifying Markers

This bill requires the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to provide provisional license holders an identifying marker that affixes to a motor vehicle and alerts other drivers that the driver of the vehicle is a new driver. The MVA is responsible for the design of the identifying marker.

## Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) expenditures would increase by $\$ 109,700$ in FY 2000. Future years reflect annualization, ongoing operating expenses, and inflation.

## Fiscal Analysis

State Expenditures: The MVA issues approximately 120,000 provisional licenses each year. Supplying each licensee with a magnetic sign and a brochure explaining the program would increase the expenditures of the MVA by approximately $\$ 106,800$ annually. Additional annual costs of $\$ 2,900$ would be incurred to publicize the program by printing and
distributing posters to MVA branches and driving instruction classrooms. Total TTF expenditures would increase in fiscal 2000 by $\$ 109,700$. This estimate reflects the bill's October 1 effective date and includes one-time costs of $\$ 26,700$ for a start-up supply of magnetic signs and brochures.
