Judiciary

Estates and Trusts - Right to Share of Intestate Net Estate, Right to Spousal Elective Share, Revocation of a Will, and Priority Right of Surviving Spouse - Pending Divorce

This emergency bill prohibits a surviving spouse from inheriting a share of the deceased spouse's estate either through a will or intestate succession if at the time of the testator's death a divorce proceeding, based on proof of excessively vicious conduct or cruelty of treatment by the surviving spouse, as evidenced by medical records or court orders, was pending.
