Senate Bill 55 (Chairman. Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee)
(Departmental - University System of Maryland)

Economic and Environmental Affairs

Higher Education - University System of Maryland - Powers and Responsibilities - Accountability

This departmental bill repeals sunset provisions applicable to:

- authorizing the Chancellor of the University System of Maryland (USM) and presidents of the USM constituent institutions to create personnel positions with existing funds;
- requiring the USM Board of Regents to submit an annual accountability report on the number of positions created; and
- requiring USM to use the statewide financial management information system.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would continue current activities for USM and would not affect funding.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: The University System of Maryland has determined that this bill will have minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Legislative Services concurs with this assessment.
