Economic and Environmental Affairs

Harford County - Local School Administration

This bill requires the Harford County Board of Education to transfer any land, school site, or building that is no longer needed for school purposes to Harford County, Maryland. Under current law, the board of education must transfer such properties to the county council.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. This bill clarifies that the governing body of Harford County is the recipient of certain surplus school property.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

Background: Since 1972 Harford County has been a charter county governed by an elected executive and a 7-member council. Harford County, Maryland is the proper legal entity for the county, not the county council.
