Senate Bill 425 (Senators Dorman and Green) Budget and Taxation

Juvenile Justice - Youth Services Bureau - Funding

This bill provides that State funds for the support of an eligible youth services bureau shall be paid directly to its private sponsor or to the local governing body, including a municipal corporation that provides matching funds for the youth services bureau. Current law provides that, at the option of the local governing body that provides the matching funds, State funds shall be paid directly to the private sponsor or the local governing body.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: Potential minimal. Youth services bureaus that are units of local government could receive funding amounts more quickly as a result of the bill.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal. Youth services bureaus that are small businesses could receive funding amounts more quickly as a result of the bill.
