Senate Bill 735 (Senators Ferguson and Moonev)

Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Frederick County - Bentz Pond Rehabilitation Project

This bill provides \$150,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Thurmont for the rehabilitation of Bentz Pond in Thurmont, including rebuilding of a dam, dredging of the pond, and renovation, repair, and capital equipping of an adjoining picnic and recreational area.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$150,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: The City of Thurmont grant revenues and expenditures would increase by \$150,000.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
