House Bill 426 (Delegate Krvsiak)

Economic Matters

Landlord and Tenant - Eviction - Extreme Weather Conditions

This bill provides a definition for “extreme weather conditions” under which an administrative judge may stay the execution of a warrant of restitution for residential property. The bill defines extreme weather conditions as precipitation in sufficient quantity to substantially damage exposed personal property or daytime high temperatures below freezing.
