 (Departmental - Morgan State University)

Appropriations

Morgan State University - Board of Regents - Membership and Residency Requirement

This departmental bill increases the membership of the Board of Regents of Morgan State University from 13 to 15. In addition, the requirement that each member of the board be a State resident is repealed. Except for the student member, at least 11 members of the board must be State residents.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. It is expected that any additional expenses resulting from the bill could be absorbed within the existing resources of Morgan State University.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Morgan State University has determined that this bill will have minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Legislative Services concurs with this assessment. (The attached assessment does not reflect amendments to the bill.)
