## Law Enforcement - Police Training - Recognition of Disabilities

This bill requires police training schools to include instruction on the nature and characteristics of individuals with "disabilities" as part of their courses of study. The bill also requires the Police Training Commission to consult with universities, colleges, and institutions for the development of courses of study for police officers on recognition and response to individuals with disabilities.
