Economic Matters

Somerset County - Alcoholic Beverages - Retail Sale of Wine

This bill authorizes the Somerset County Board of License Commissioners to issue a Class A (light wine) license for retail sale of wine to a Class 3 or Class 4 licensed manufacturer. The annual fee is \$50.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: There are currently no Class 3 or Class 4 licensed manufacturers in Somerset County. Future revenues would increase by \$50 annually for each Class 3 or Class 4 winery that is established and applies for a Class A license.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
