**Department of State Police - Communication Systems - Responsibility**

---

This departmental bill provides that the communications systems maintained by the Department of State Police that may be used by or connected with any law enforcement agency of the State, or State agency authorized by the department, must include: (1) the Maryland Interagency Law Enforcement System (MILES); (2) the National Crime Information Center (NCIC); and (3) the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS).

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. This bill provides statutory clarification of the data communications systems currently maintained by the Department of State Police and available for use by other authorized agencies in the State.

**Local Effect:** None.
