House Bill 237 (Delegate Clagett. et al.)

Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Anne Arundel County - Smithsonian Environmental Research Center

This bill provides \$500,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Smithsonian Institution for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of housing units at the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center in Anne Arundel County. The housing units will be used by visiting scientists and postdoctoral students, as well as educators, and other individuals conducting research at the center.

The Smithsonian Institution must provide matching funds by June 1, 2001.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$500,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.
