State Government - State Advisory Council on Administrative Hearings - Composition

This bill increases the number of members on the State Advisory Council on Administrative Hearings from nine to ten. The added member must be a nongovernmental attorney who practices before the Office of Administrative Hearings. In total, not more than five members may be attorneys who practice before the Office of Administrative Hearings, versus the current limit of four such attorneys.

The bill takes effect June 1, 1999.
