House Joint Resolution 17 (Baltimore County Delegation. *et al.*)
Economic Matters

Support for the Maersk/Sea-Land Proposal Serving the Port of Baltimore

This joint resolution provides that the General Assembly supports the Port of Baltimore's initiative to grow cargo by aggressively participating in the effort to secure Maersk/Sea-Land business. The resolution urges that sufficient funding be allocated to the port in order to make the necessary physical improvements to accommodate the substantial increase in business generated by Maersk/Sea-Land. The resolution further provides that the General Assembly is in full support of the Governor, the Maryland Department of Transportation, the Port of Baltimore, and the Department of Business and Economic Development in their negotiations with Maersk/Sea-Land.
