## FISCAL NOTE

Senate Bill 317 (Senator Bromwell)

Finance

Commercial Law - Mortgage Loan Settlement Fees for Photocopying and Electronic Facsimile Transmittal Services - Actual Costs

This bill prohibits a lender or credit grantor from charging settlement fees on first and second mortgage loan borrowers for photocopying or faxing services that are more than the actual cost incurred by the person that performs the service. The bill applies only to a mortgage or deed of trust on the borrower's primary residence, not a commercial loan.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. This bill would not affect the operations or finances of the Division of Financial Regulation. Assuming that the Consumer Protection Division receives fewer than 50 complaints as a result of this bill, any additional workload could be handled with existing resources.
