### **School Vehicles - Use of Flashing Warning Signals**

This bill authorizes a school vehicle driver to activate the vehicle's alternately flashing warning signals when exiting school grounds while carrying students at dismissal time.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** None. Authorizing a school vehicle driver to activate the vehicle's warning signals while exiting school grounds will not affect local school expenditures.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**Background:** Under current law, a school vehicle driver can only activate the vehicle's alternately flashing warning signal when the school vehicle is stopping or stopped on a roadway for the purpose of receiving or discharging passengers or when approaching another school vehicle in the act of loading or unloading passengers.
