Commerce and Government Matters

Financial Institutions - Automated Teller Machines - Surcharges

This bill prohibits a financial institution from assessing a surcharge against an individual who conducts a transaction at an automated teller machine if the transaction does not relate to or affect an account held by the individual with the financial institution that is the owner or operator of the machine.
