**Economic Matters** 

Insurance - Property and Casualty - Refusal to Issue or Renew - Geographic Area

This departmental bill requires an insurer to have the approval of the Insurance Commissioner before the insurer refuses to issue or renew motor vehicle, property, or casualty insurance solely because an insured's address is in a certain geographic location.
