FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 688 (Delegate Rosenberg)

Environmental Matters

Environmental Sanitarians - Licensees and Applicants - Public Records

This bill requires the State Board of Environmental Sanitarians to keep a current record of the names and addresses of environmental sanitarians licensed by the board in the previous two years and to provide this record, upon request, to a local government unit. The bill does not preclude a local government unit from acquiring the names and addresses of environmental sanitarians who have applied for employment with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH). DHMH is required to permit an inspection by a local government unit, upon request, of the names and addresses of environmental sanitarians who have applied for employment with the department in the previous two years.
