**Family Law - Domestic Violence - Relief**

---

This bill authorizes a court to include in a temporary ex parte order or protective order a provision ordering the respondent to remain away from a child care provider of a person eligible for relief from abuse while a child of the person is in the care of the child care provider.

The bill applies only to petitions for relief from abuse filed after the bill's October 1, 1999 effective date.
