**Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Minority Access Community Center**

---

This bill provides \$450,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Minority Access, Inc. for the planning, design, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of a building in Hyattsville. The building will be used by Minority Access, Inc. as the Minority Access Community Center to provide a variety of services to people of the surrounding area, and including a community art center.

The board must provide \$450,000 in matching funds by June 1, 2001. The matching fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** This \$450,000 grant would be part of the total \$445 million general obligation debt authorization for FY 2000 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$445 million would be a maximum of \$45.3 million annually based on the 4.26% interest rate realized at the February 24, 1999 bond sale.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal.
