Judicial Proceedings

Handgun Permits - Law Enforcement Exception

This departmental bill adds full-time assistant sheriffs' deputies and part-time sheriffs' deputies to the list of law enforcement officers exempt from State handgun permit requirements relating to wearing, carrying, or transporting handguns when they are on active law enforcement assignment so long as the handgun is a duly authorized piece of official equipment.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not materially affect State finances. The initial handgun registration fee is \$75 and the annual renewal fee is \$50.

Local Effect: None.
