(Departmental - Assessments and Taxation)

Budget and Taxation

Supervisors of Assessments - Residency Requirement

This departmental bill authorizes the appropriate county official to waive the residency requirement for a supervisor of assessments. Under current law, the residency requirement can only be waived in Baltimore City.

The bill is effective July 1, 1999.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Providing greater flexibility to the counties in nominating a supervisor of assessments will not directly affect local government finances.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Assessments and Taxation has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Legislative Services concurs with this assessment.
