Volunteer Health Care Providers and Physicians - Immunity - Insurance Coverage

This bill amends current law that relates to liability limitations for volunteer health care providers. Under current law, a volunteer health care provider may be liable for damages up to the limit of insurance coverage. A volunteer health care provider is not liable for damages in excess of the limit of insurance coverage unless the volunteer health care provider's act constitutes willful misconduct, gross negligence, or an intentional tort. The bill provides that volunteer health care providers are immune from suit, regardless of insurance coverage, unless their acts constitute willful misconduct, gross negligence, or an intentional tort.
