Judicial Proceedings

Juror Information - Dissemination

This bill allows a jury commissioner or court clerk to disclose to the State Board of Elections information indicating that a prospective juror:

- moved outside the county where the circuit court is located;
- is not a citizen; or
- died.

Any such disclosures must be made in the manner provided in the applicable juror selection plan and in accordance with confidentiality regulations adopted by the State Board of Elections.
