Radioactive Waste Task Force

This bill requires the Maryland Department of the Environment to convene a 17-member radioactive waste task force by January 1, 2000 to develop a comprehensive strategy for the future reduction, treatment, use, management, and disposal of radioactive waste in Maryland. The task force is required to report to the Governor, the Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee, and the House Environmental Matters Committee by October 1, 2002.

This bill sunsets September 30, 2003.
