House Bill 819 (Prince George's County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Fees
PG 302-99

This bill for Prince George's County increases by 10% the licensing fees for all licenses except Special Class C (country club) and Class B (hotel) licenses which remain unchanged.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County revenues would increase by \$69,175 annually, assuming the number of licenses remains constant.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: Revenues would increase by \$69,175 annually, based on the current number of licenses, as shown below:
