Medical Records - Disclosure to Health Care Provider's Insurer or Legal Counsel

This bill amends current law to permit a health care provider to disclose an individual's medical record to the provider's insurer or legal counsel relating to a potential or actual claim against the provider, provided the insurer or legal counsel: (1) notifies the individual that disclosure of the individual's medical record is sought; (2) notifies the individual of this provision of law on which the requesting party relies in seeking disclosure of information; (3) notifies the individual of the procedure for filing a motion to quash or a motion for a protective order; and (4) mails the notification to the individual by certified mail, return receipt requested, 15 days before the request for disclosure of the medical record is served on the health care provider. Current law does not require any type of notice be given to the individual whose medical records are sought.
