### **Maryland Building Performance Standards - Time Limits**

This bill alters the time period in which the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has to incorporate subsequent versions of the BOCA National Building Code into the Maryland Building Performance Standards from 9 months to 24 months. The bill also alters the date on which the Maryland Building Performance Standards shall apply to counties or municipalities that have adopted the standard building code issued by the Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc. from August 1, 1999 to August 1, 2001.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1999.
