**Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Service by Minors**

---

This bill authorizes a person at least 18 years of age to serve or sell alcoholic beverages in a restaurant in connection with the serving of a meal in Garrett County. Under current law, a person between the ages of 18 and 21 may only serve alcoholic beverages from a service bar.

The bill is effective July 1, 1999.
