AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 17, strike "adoption" and substitute "sponsorship"; and in line 21, strike "Governor" and substitute "State".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 23 through 31, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZES THE INCREASE IN WATER-ORIENTED RECREATION ON MARYLAND'S WATERWAYS, AND THE DESIRE FOR ACCESS TO WATERWAYS AND OVERNIGHT CAMPING FACILITIES ALONG WATERWAYS.
- (B) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZES THE CREATION OF THE MARYLAND MILLENNIUM WATER TRAILS PROGRAM, TO BE DEVELOPED BY A DEPARTMENT-APPOINTED STEERING COMMITTEE AND ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT, TO PROMOTE THE HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, AND NATURAL RESOURCES OF MARYLAND'S WATERWAYS, AND TO ESTABLISH A COORDINATED, ENVIRONMENTALLY SOUND SYSTEM OF WATER ROUTES AND CAMPSITES ALONG EACH WATER ROUTE IN MARYLAND."

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 8 through 10, inclusive, and substitute:

"(2) TO DETERMINE THE MOST APPROPRIATE TYPES OF WATERCRAFT FOR USE ON SPECIFIC WATER TRAILS BASED ON THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE WATERCRAFT AND THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE WATER TRAIL;
