AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "penalty;" insert "<u>repealing a certain labeling requirement that</u> applies to a seller of tobacco products through a vending machine;"; and after line 15, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article - Business Regulation</u> <u>Section 16-209</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 17, insert:

"<u>16-209.</u>

(a) <u>A licensee shall display a license in the way that the Comptroller requires by</u> regulation.

(b) <u>A licensee who sells cigarettes through a vending machine:</u>

(1) <u>shall place each package of cigarettes in the machine so that when the</u> package is visible the tax stamps required by § 12-304 of the Tax - General Article are also visible; <u>and</u>

- (2) in the way that the Comptroller requires by regulation, shall[:
 - (i)] identify each vending machine with a conspicuous label that states the

licensee's name, address, and telephone number[; and

(ii) display on a conspicuous label applicable prohibitions and penalties under Article 27, §§ 404 and 405 of the Code].".
