AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 271

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "penalty;" insert "repealing a certain labeling requirement that applies to a seller of tobacco products through a vending machine;"; and after line 15, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Business Regulation

Section 16-209

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 17, insert:

"16-209.

(a) A licensee shall display a license in the way that the Comptroller requires by regulation.

(b) A licensee who sells cigarettes through a vending machine:

(1) shall place each package of cigarettes in the machine so that when the package is visible the tax stamps required by § 12-304 of the Tax - General Article are also visible; and

(2) in the way that the Comptroller requires by regulation, shall:

(i) identify each vending machine with a conspicuous label that states the

licensee's name, address, and telephone number[; and

(ii) display on a conspicuous label applicable prohibitions and penalties under Article 27, §§ 404 and 405 of the Code].”.
