AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "Political" in line 2 down through "Check" in line 3; in line 8, after "transferred;" insert "repealing a requirement that in elections for certain offices the name of a candidate be identified by the county in which the candidate resides;"; strike beginning with "the" in line 9 down through "transfer" in line 11 and substitute "election law"; and in line 25, after "Section" insert "9-210(h) and".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 15, insert:

"9-210.

- (h) [(1) In an election for an office that represents more than one county, in whole or in part, the name of a candidate shall be identified by the county in which the candidate resides.
- (2)] A candidate for President of the United States or Vice President of the United States shall be identified by the state in which the candidate resides.".
