AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 621

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, strike “encourage” and substitute “provide information to”; in line 10, after “Commission” insert “, certain persons,”; in line 11, strike “propose” and substitute “report on the possibility of”; and in line 12, strike “and proposal”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 4 and 5, strike beginning with line 35 on page 4 through line 2 on page 5, inclusive, and substitute:

“(E) THE SECRETARY SHALL DEVELOP A PROGRAM, IN CONSULTATION WITH APPROPRIATE AGENCIES, THAT WILL PROVIDE INFORMATION TO INELIGIBLE MARYLAND PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM APPLICANTS REGARDING OTHER PROGRAMS THAT THEY MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR INCLUDING FREE PROGRAMS OFFERED BY DRUG MANUFACTURERS.” .

On page 5, in line 6, strike “propose” and substitute “report on the possibility of”; and in line 10, strike “proposal” and substitute “findings”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 5, after “Commission” insert “, the Department of Aging, the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy, two senior citizens appointed by the Governor,”.
