AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1082

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "Detention" in line 2 down through "Alternatives" in line 3 and substitute "Juvenile Justice System - Standards"; in line 6, strike "develop" and substitute "adopt"; in the same line, after "conduct;" insert "requiring the Department to require private agencies under contract with the Department to adopt a certain code of conduct;"; strike beginning with the second "requiring" in line 6 down through "facility" in line 12 and substitute "requiring the Department to adopt regulations that require certain facilities to provide certain programs"; in line 13, strike "standards"; strike beginning with "to" in line 15 down through "detention" in line 16; strike beginning with "juvenile" in line 17 down through "alternatives" in line 18 and substitute "the juvenile justice system"; in line 21, strike ", 2-120, and 2-125"; and in line 26, strike ", 2-135, and 2-136" and substitute "and 2-135".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 13, strike "(I)"; in the same line, after "SHALL" insert ":

(I);

in the same line, strike "DEVELOP" and substitute "ADOPT"; strike beginning with the period in line 13 down through "TO" in line 14 and substitute "FOR"; and strike beginning with "AND" in line 15 down through "LAW" in line 20 and substitute ";AND

(II) REQUIRE PRIVATE AGENCIES UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO ADOPT A CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PRIVATE AGENCY STAFF THAT IS IN SUBSTANTIAL COMPLIANCE WITH THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PERSONNEL OF THE DEPARTMENT".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

(Over)

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 19 through 21, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 3 through line 13 on page 4, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 19, inclusive; and in line 32, after "(1)" insert "A POLICY THAT ELIMINATES THE UNNECESSARY USE OF DETENTION AND PLACES A PRIORITY ON THE USE OF DIVERSION AND APPROPRIATE NONSECURE ALTERNATIVES;

(2)".

On page 5, in lines 1, 2, 4, 6, and 9, respectively, strike "(2)", "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", and "(6)", respectively, and substitute "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", and "(7)", respectively; in line 9, after "CHILD;" insert "AND"; strike lines 10 and 11 in their entirety; and in line 14, strike "2-136" and substitute "2-135".

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 5, in line 1, after "FACILITY" insert "THAT MAY NOT BE EXCEEDED EXCEPT IN EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES DURING WHICH TIME STAFFING RATIOS AND LEVELS OF SERVICES SHALL BE MAINTAINED".

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 5, in line 4, after "TRAINING," insert "INCLUDING TRAINING IN RECOGNIZING AND REPORTING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT,"; in line 6, strike "PROVISIONS REGARDING"; and in line 9, after "OF" insert "EXCESSIVE".

AMENDMENT NO. 8

On page 5, strike beginning with "MONITORING" in line 12 down through "OF" in line 13 and substitute "INTERNAL AUDITING AND MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES IN".

AMENDMENT NO. 9

On page 5, in line 15, strike "(A)"; in the same line, after "DEVELOP" insert "AND ADOPT REGULATIONS PROVIDING STANDARDS FOR"; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 19, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 10

On page 6, in line 14, strike "JUVENILE DETENTION" and substitute "STATE CARE AND CUSTODY".

AMENDMENT NO. 11

On page 7, in line 7, strike "July" and substitute "October".
