# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1082 (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "Detention" in line 2 down through "Alternatives" in line 3 and substitute "<u>Juvenile Justice System - Standards</u>"; in line 6, strike "develop" and substitute "<u>adopt</u>"; in the same line, after "conduct;" insert "<u>requiring the Department to require private agencies</u> <u>under contract with the Department to adopt a certain code of conduct;</u>"; strike beginning with the second "requiring" in line 6 down through "facility" in line 12 and substitute "<u>requiring the Department to adopt regulations that require certain facilities to provide certain programs</u>"; in line 13, strike "standards"; strike beginning with "to" in line 15 down through "detention" in line 16; strike beginning with "juvenile" in line 17 down through "alternatives" in line 18 and substitute "<u>the juvenile justice system</u>"; in line 21, strike ", 2-120, and 2-125"; and in line 26, strike ", 2-135, and 2-136" and substitute "<u>and 2-135</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 13, strike "(I)"; in the same line, after "SHALL" insert ":

<u>(I)</u>";

in the same line, strike "DEVELOP" and substitute "<u>ADOPT</u>"; strike beginning with the period in line 13 down through "TO" in line 14 and substitute "<u>FOR</u>"; and strike beginning with "AND" in line 15 down through "LAW" in line 20 and substitute "<u>; AND</u>

(II) REQUIRE PRIVATE AGENCIES UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO ADOPT A CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PRIVATE AGENCY STAFF THAT IS IN SUBSTANTIAL COMPLIANCE WITH THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PERSONNEL OF THE DEPARTMENT".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 19 through 21, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 4

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 3 through line 13 on page 4, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 19, inclusive; and in line 32, after "(1)" insert "<u>A POLICY THAT ELIMINATES THE UNNECESSARY USE OF DETENTION AND PLACES A PRIORITY ON THE USE OF DIVERSION AND APPROPRIATE NONSECURE ALTERNATIVES;</u>

#### <u>(2)</u>".

On page 5, in lines 1, 2, 4, 6, and 9, respectively, strike "(2)", "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", and "(6)", respectively, and substitute "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", and "(7)", respectively; in line 9, after "CHILD;" insert "<u>AND</u>"; strike lines 10 and 11 in their entirety; and in line 14, strike "2-136" and substitute "<u>135</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 5, in line 1, after "FACILITY" insert "<u>THAT MAY NOT BE EXCEEDED EXCEPT</u> <u>IN EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES DURING WHICH TIME STAFFING RATIOS AND</u> <u>LEVELS OF SERVICES SHALL BE MAINTAINED</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 5, in line 4, after "TRAINING," insert "<u>INCLUDING TRAINING IN</u> <u>RECOGNIZING AND REPORTING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT,</u>"; in line 6, strike "PROVISIONS REGARDING"; and in line 9, after "OF" insert "<u>EXCESSIVE</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 8

On page 5, strike beginning with "MONITORING" in line 12 down through "OF" in line 13 and substitute "<u>INTERNAL AUDITING AND MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES</u> <u>IN</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 9

On page 5, in line 15, strike "(A)"; in the same line, after "DEVELOP" insert "<u>AND ADOPT</u> <u>REGULATIONS PROVIDING STANDARDS FOR</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 19, inclusive. HB1082/542919/1 Amendments to HB 1082 Page 3 of 3
