AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 153
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "Office;" insert "prohibiting amounts in the administrative cost account to be used to increase by more than a certain percentage certain appropriations;"; and in line 10, after "review;" insert "requiring the Comptroller to submit certain reports by certain dates; and providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 9, after "OFFICE" insert "NOR MAY AMOUNTS IN THE ACCOUNT BE USED TO INCREASE BY MORE THAN 5% THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COMPLIANCE DIVISION AUTHORIZED IN THE STATE BUDGET AS ENACTED".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 12, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Comptroller shall report on or before October 1, 2001 and October 1, 2002, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on the additional revenues collected as a result of the increased expenditures enabled under this Act.";

in line 13, strike "2." and substitute "3."; and in line 14, after "2000." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
