AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 363

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 4 and 5, strike "compensation and reimbursement"; and in lines 5 and 6, strike "establishing certain subcommittees for certain purposes;" and substitute "requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to convene a certain summit on the crisis in nursing;".

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 3 on page 3 through line 31 on page 4, inclusive, and substitute:

"(3) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE;

(4) THE SECRETARY OF THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(5) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE HEALTH SERVICES COST REVIEW COMMISSION, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

(6) THE DIRECTOR OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION, OR A NURSE DESIGNATED BY THE DIRECTOR;

(7) THE DEAN OF A UNIVERSITY-BASED SCHOOL OF NURSING APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND COUNCIL OF THE BACCALAUREATE AND HIGHER DEGREE PROGRAMS;

(8) ONE PRACTICING NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND NURSES ASSOCIATION;

(Over)

(9) A SCHOOL HEALTH NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL HEALTH NURSES;

(10) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DISABILITY SERVICES COMMUNITY WHO IS A NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES;

(11) A PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND COUNCIL OF PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING DIRECTORS;

(12) A HOSPITAL REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR, APPOINTED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND HOSPITALS AND HEALTH SYSTEMS;

(13) A NURSING REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF NONPROFIT HOMES FOR THE AGING;

(14) A NURSING HOME REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR, APPOINTED BY THE HEALTH FACILITIES ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND;

(15) A UNION REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION;

(16) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A TEMPORARY NURSE STAFFING AGENCY, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ORGANIZATION OF NURSE EXECUTIVES;

(17) A HOME CARE NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL HOME CARE ASSOCIATION;

(18) A STUDENT NURSE REPRESENTATIVE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF STUDENT NURSES;

(19) A PHYSICIAN, APPOINTED BY MEDCHI;

(20) A PRACTICING CRITICAL CARE NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE CHESAPEAKE BAY CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF CRITICAL CARE NURSES;

(21) A PRACTICING REHABILITATION NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF REHABILITATION NURSES, MARYLAND CHAPTER;

(22) A PRACTICING BEHAVIORAL HOME HEALTH NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE BEHAVIORAL HOME HEALTH NURSES ASSOCIATION;

(23) A PRACTICING PERIOPERATIVE NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF PERIOPERATIVE REGISTERED NURSES;

(24) A PRACTICING OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES;

(25) PRACTICING PERIANESTHESIA NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE SOCIETY OF PERIANESTHESIA NURSES;

(26) A PRACTICING GASTROENTEROLOGY NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE SOCIETY OF GASTROENTEROLOGY NURSES;

(27) A PRACTICING OPHTHALMIC NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE SOCIETY OF OPHTHALMIC NURSES;

(28) A PRACTICING EMERGENCY NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND STATE COUNCIL OF EMERGENCY NURSES ASSOCIATION;

(29) A PRACTICING ONCOLOGY NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE ONCOLOGY NURSING SOCIETY;

(30) A REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND

(Over)

ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES;

(31) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION OPERATING IN THE STATE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF HEALTH PLANS;

(32) A CONSUMER REPRESENTATIVE, APPOINTED BY THE UNITED SENIORS OF MARYLAND;

(33) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND

(34) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 1, after “(II)” insert “APPOINT AS VICE CHAIRS, FROM THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION:

1. THE DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND NURSING SCHOOL;

2. A DEAN OF AN INDEPENDENT COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF NURSING, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION;

3. A DIRECTOR OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF ASSOCIATE DEGREE DIRECTORS OF NURSING;

4. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE BOARD OF NURSING;

5. A NURSE EXECUTIVE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF NURSE EXECUTIVES;

6. A PRACTICING REGISTERED NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND NURSES ASSOCIATION;

7. A PRACTICING LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES ASSOCIATION; AND

8. THE PROJECT DIRECTOR OF THE COLLEAGUES IN CARE PROJECT;

(III)”;

and in line 3, strike “(III)” and substitute “(IV)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 17, after “CONVENE” insert “A CRISIS IN NURSING SUMMIT”; and after line 20, insert “IN ADDITION TO THE ISSUES IDENTIFIED AND PRIORITIZED AS A RESULT OF THE SUMMIT CONVENEED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,”.

On page 6, strike beginning with “A” in line 10 down through “(F)” in line 14; in line 16, strike “(G)” and substitute “(F)”; and after line 20, insert:

“(G) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.”.
