AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 363

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "compensation" in line 4 down through "reimbursement," in line 5; and strike beginning with "establishing" in line 5 down through "purposes:" in line 6 and substitute "requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to convene a certain summit on the crisis in nursing:".

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 3 on page 3 down through line 31 on page 4, inclusive, and substitute:

"(3) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE;

(4) THE SECRETARY OF THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(5) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE HEALTH SERVICES COST REVIEW COMMISSION, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

(6) THE DIRECTOR OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OR A NURSE DESIGNATED BY THE DIRECTOR;

(7) THE DEAN OF A UNIVERSITY-BASED SCHOOL OF NURSING;

(8) ONE PRACTICING NURSE;

(9) A SCHOOL HEALTH NURSE;

(Over)

(10) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DISABILITY SERVICES COMMUNITY WHO IS A NURSE;

(11) A PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE;

(12) A HOSPITAL REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR;

(13) A NURSING REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR OF A NONPROFIT NURSING HOME;

(14) A NURSING HOME REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSING DIRECTOR OF A FOR-PROFIT NURSING HOME;

(15) A UNION REPRESENTATIVE, WHO IS A NURSE;

(16) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A TEMPORARY NURSE STAFFING AGENCY;

(17) A HOME CARE NURSE;

(18) A STUDENT NURSE REPRESENTATIVE;

(19) A PHYSICIAN;

(20) A PRACTICING CRITICAL CARE NURSE;

(21) A PRACTICING REHABILITATION NURSE;

(34) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY
THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND

(35) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, after line 33 insert:

“(II) APPOINT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION; AND

(III) APPOINT AS VICE CHAIRS:

1. TWO DEANS FROM UNIVERSITY BASED SCHOOLS OF

(Over)

NURSING;

2. A DEAN OF AN INDEPENDENT COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF NURSING;

3. A DIRECTOR OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM;

4. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE BOARD OF NURSING;

5. A NURSE EXECUTIVE;

6. A PRACTICING REGISTERED NURSE;

7. A PRACTICING LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE; AND

8. THE PROJECT DIRECTOR OF THE COLLEAGUES IN CARE PROJECT;”.

On page 5, in lines 1 and 3, strike “(II)” and “(III)”, respectively, and substitute “(IV)” and “(V)”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 17, after “CONVENE” insert “A CRISIS IN NURSING SUMMIT”; and after line 20, insert “IN ADDITION TO THE ISSUES IDENTIFIED AND PRIORITIZED AS A RESULT OF THE SUMMIT CONVENED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,”.

On page 6, strike beginning with “A” in line 10 down through “(F)” in line 14; in line 16, strike “(G)” and substitute “(F)”; and after line 20, insert:

“(G) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.”.
